'Ot.

"He sent his 'ot and wonders into your midst."

An 'ot is a sign that points to a bigger reality. Like whenever a rainbow appears, it's an 'ot, a visual reminder of God's promise to Noah that he will never again flood the world with rain.

Or when God causes plagues in Egypt, they're an 'ot, a sign telling Pharaoh and his people that Yahweh is the bigger, more powerful reality.

God also calls the seventh-day Sabbath rest an 'ot. It's a weekly celebration pointing to God's continuous provision and promise of ongoing peace and rest.

God tells Moses, "Say to the Israelites, 'You shall keep my Sabbaths, for this is an 'ot between me and you for generations to come.'"
